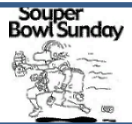

HELP WILL BE NEEDED FOR LENTEN LUNCHES.....



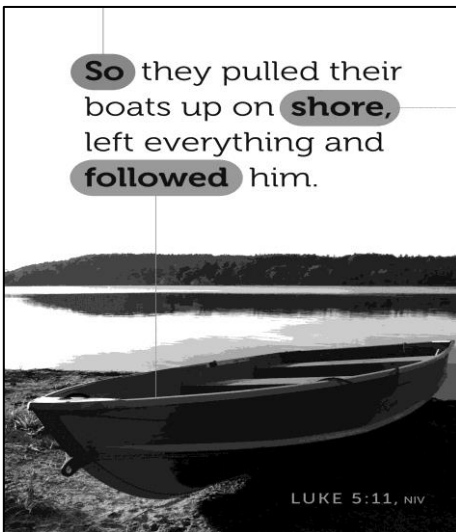
