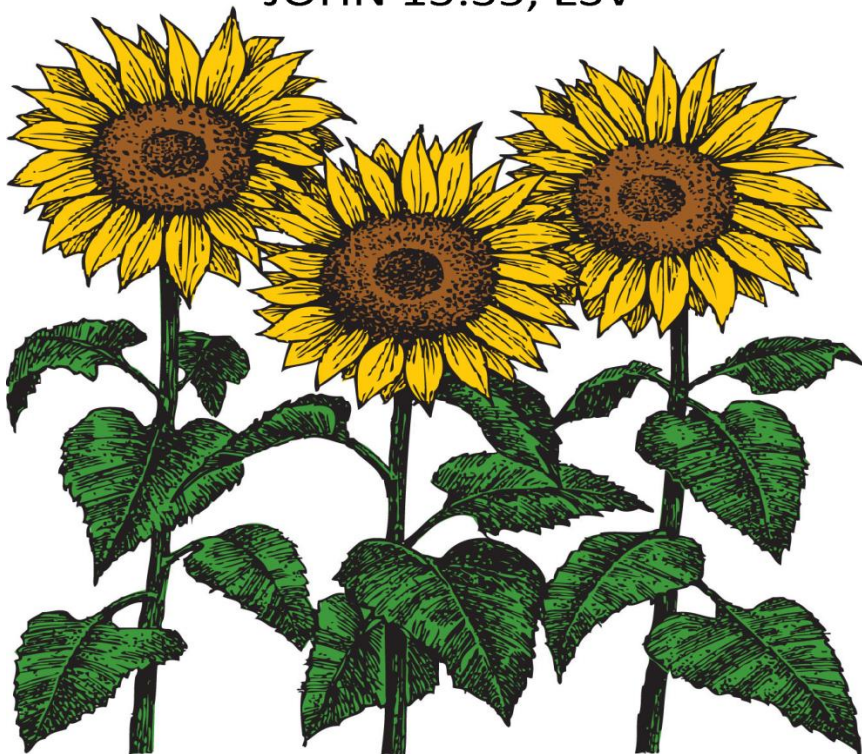


Fifth Sunday of Easter
