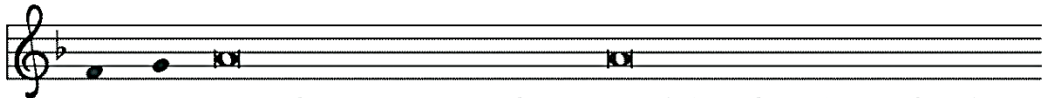

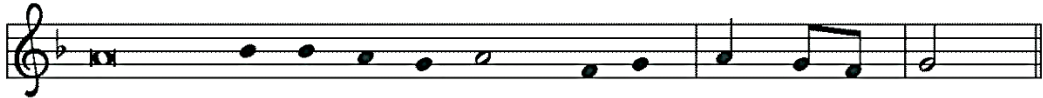

**Amen**


## **LORD'S PRAYER**
