

FROM THE PARISH NURSE

Matter of balance tip: to prevent falling when its icy remember to walk like a penguin: feet slightly turned out, knees a little bent and

arms straight pointing out from the body (make a triangle with your head the point of the triangle and your arms the other 2 points). Then walk like a penguin, small shuffle steps. Check the soles of your boots and shoes to be sure the tread isn't worn smooth.

Remember to go to the emergency room if you have chest pain, change in level of consciousness, excessive bleeding from a wound, mouth or rectum or excruciating constant pain. It's best to see your health care provider or go to one of the walk-in clinics for other problems. You will wait hours in the emergency room if it's not a life-threatening problem. If you have an orthopedic emergency ORA has walk in hours 8-5pm Mon-Fri, no referral or appointment needed, you only need to call 911 or drive to the hospital if you have an open fracture.

UnityPoint Health – Trinity is in need of volunteers (aged 14-years on up) that have a passion for helping others. We could really use help with things, such as: serving as a befriender, answering phones, stuffing envelopes, transporting patients in wheelchairs, delivering supplies to units, helping in our Gift Shops, creating floral arrangements, pricing merchandise, providing wayfinding instructions to visitors, or entering data. Some of these tasks can be done on an individual basis or with a friend.

Time commitment is very minimal; shifts are typically: 8 am-noon, noon-4pm, or 4-7 pm. We have volunteers that come in once/week, while others volunteer 2-3 shifts/week. It's really up to the volunteer. We are very flexible.

Completed commitment forms can be placed in the offering plate or submitted to the office.


