From the Pastor,

Periodically I get questions from members about parts of our liturgy or things related to the church calendar. I thought that this month I would address a couple of those issues.

First, I was asked recently about why we continue to have the Easter banner up even though Easter Sunday was several weeks ago. The simple answer is that it has to do with the importance of the resurrection in the life of the church.

The longer answer (preachers are rarely accused of saying something in a few words when a longer explanation is possible) requires that we back up to Lent. Lent, of course, is the penitential season that prepares us for the gift of Easter. It is 40 days long. (Not counting Sundays. I can explain that to you later if you want.)

So, if the time of preparation is 40 days, then the celebration itself should be longer. Hence, our Easter celebration is not just a day, or a week, but a “week of weeks.” In other words, to properly celebrate Jesus resurrection, our festival lasts for seven weeks. During the seven Sundays of Easter, then, we continue to light the Christ candle and leave up our Easter decorations.

Easter ends, then, on the fiftieth day, or Pentecost. (Note that “pente” is a Greek word related to the word “five” as in pentagon.) On Pentecost we celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit to the church to continue the work of resurrected and ascended Christ.

So, there’s the long answer to a short question.

Second, I want to briefly touch on the Kyrie that is a part of our weekly worship. Simply, *kyrie* is a Greek word that is translated as “Lord.” When we sing the “Kyrie” we use the words *kyrie eleison*, which means “Lord, have mercy.” So in our current liturgy, when we sing *kyrie eleison*, we are praying that the Lord would have mercy on our world, the church, the hungry and poor, our friends and family, and on our daily lives. I believe that is such a beautiful and appropriate prayer that we offer every week.

If you have other questions about the liturgy or the church year or other things “churchy,” please don’t hesitate to ask. You are likely not the only person wondering such things.

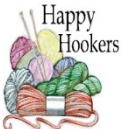


MARK YOU CALENDARS! CAFÉ ON VINE – June 21
