From the Pastor,

Every year when I was a child, my father would pick up an Advent calendar for our family. It was a large, maybe 11" x 17", tri folded sheet of card stock with a glittering Christmas image printed on it. Within the image were little doors numbered one to twenty-five, one door for each day of Advent and Christmas Day. Accompanying the calendar was a sheet with little poems for each day that gave a clue to what was pictured behind each door. I loved getting that Advent calendar every year as I and my brothers would take turns opening the doors. It was exciting, as a child, to be counting down the days to Christmas.

I believe that Advent calendar served a couple purposes.

First, the calendar helped build up the anticipation of the coming Christmas day. As each day passed the excitement grew, knowing that Christmas was imminent. I could literally see the number of days until Christmas was upon us. There was clearly an end to Advent and the arrival of the great day.

At the same time, I think the Advent calendar slowed down time for me. I could see that Christmas was 22 or 15 or 5 days away. I knew it was coming. But the calendar also served as reminder that Christmas was not yet here. It was in the future, and I needed to wait for it.

My memories of the Advent calendar reflect what I believe the season of Advent in the Christian church is about. Advent is a time of building excitement and anticipation. In the Advent season we not only anticipate the arrival of Christmas, but also the arrival of the



reign of God through Jesus. Each day brings us closer to God's kingdom. That great day is coming and we can almost see it. Yet, at the same time, Advent is also a season when we acknowledge that it is not yet Christmas. God's reign is not quite here. And so, we must patiently (or impatiently) wait. We live in faith that God is coming (just as we know that Christmas is coming). But we also know that it is not here yet. And so, we wait. Excited and hopeful for what we know is coming, we wait.



### WELCA LADIES CHRISTMAS LUNCHEON DECEMBER 3 @ 11:30 am AT PAGALO'S in MILAN









### A note about Calvary's finances:

The congregation council wants you to be aware of the congregation's financial situation. The Calvary administration, working to be the best possible stewards of the congregation's resources, has reduced expenses to date for 2025 by just over \$9,000 compared to 2024. Spending is also under budget for the year to date. Unfortunately, offerings and other income has dropped significantly. The congregation has received more than \$18,000 less in 2025. The treasurer has been able to use savings from previous years to keep the congregation current with all our bills and other obligations. However, those reserves are running out.
